

Everett I.L. Baker Library @ Norwalk Community College

Named after the first President of Norwalk Community College when it became part of the State of Connecticut Community College system in 1966, the Baker Library supports the educational needs of our faculty and students. This flyer highlights some of the services available to NCC students.

Resource and Study Center: 2 Student Group Study Rooms with white boards, skeleton model (Gift of the Nursing Class of 2006), electronic keyboard; 52 Computers including 2 iMacs, 1 assisted learning computer, all but 6 with NCC licensed software; Networked Printers (Free Black & White Only); 5 DVD/VHS players and monitors; 2 Black & White Photocopiers (\$0.10/copy); 1 Color Photocopier (\$0.50/copy)

NCC Student ID/Library Cards [form to handout] No Cost (\$2.00 Replacement Fee if Lost)

You must be a currently enrolled NCC Student. Bring a copy of your registration receipt with the Student ID Number to speed processing. You must also bring a valid picture ID card (e.g. CT Driver's License or Passport). Don't wait until classes start or the wait time will be much longer. Your card entitles NCC students to discounts where ever available.

Borrow and Access Library Materials

The Library own books, films, or CDs for coursework or recreational reading, viewing, or listening.
